Biology (2) – Anatomy and Physiology descriptors posted as final

Discipline Status Report

Anthropology – 1 descriptor Intro to Language and Culture) re-posted for vetting until October 15

Biology – 2 descriptors posted for vetting until October 15: FDRG will be meeting soon to prepare 2 additional descriptors (for the TMC) & the TMC for vetting (early Fall)

Communication – 1 draft descriptor (Persuasion) posted for vetting until October 15

Economics – draft descriptor and TMC to be posted this fall

Journalism – 1 descriptor posted for vetting until October 15

Kinesiology – Kinesiology has recently drafted 5 descriptors for their activity courses and grouped them according to the activity areas (e.g. "aquatics"). They will be posted until October 15.

Mathematics - 8 descriptors posted for re-vetting until October 15; some of these courses need to be reviewed by Business, Computer Science or other faculty.

Philosophy – TMC reposted until October 15

Radio/TV/Film – draft descriptors and TMC to be posted this fall for vetting

Spanish – TMC and 2 new descriptors posted until October 31

October 15 is fast approaching!! PLEASE, PLEASE remind your faculty to participate in the vetting process! Sign them up for the list-servs! Many of these descriptors were re-posted from Spring due to insufficient feedback.
