

Update on Approved Courses and TMCs

Presently, **90 CCCs** have courses that have been granted C-ID numbers; **1836** approved courses (includes TCSU courses)

Top 4:

- 1) Santa Rosa (103)
- 2) American River (81)
- 3) Hartnell (56)
- 4) San Bernardino Valley (53)

11 CSU Campuses have identified **974** courses as comparable to C-ID descriptors.

346 (140 AG) C-ID descriptors have been approved – in **30** disciplines

Discipline Status Report

Many descriptors close to final posting

Anthropology – 1 descriptor ANTH 130 Intro to Language and Culture) will be posted as final within the coming days

Biology –FDRG members will meet in person this month to potentially finalize 2 additional descriptors 115S and 130S and prepare additional descriptors to post for vetting with the draft TMC

Communication Studies – 1 draft descriptor (Persuasion) closed October 15. FDRG is being convened to finalize this month

Economics – draft TMC and 2 or 3 descriptors to be posted for vetting soon

Engineering - 2 draft Model Curricula (with survey questions) and 11 descriptors posted for vetting until December 14.

Journalism – 1 descriptor closed vetting October 31; FDRG to be convened to finalize this month

Kinesiology – 5 descriptors for activity course categories finished vetting November 15. FDRG being convened this month to finalize.

Mathematics - 8 draft descriptors closed vetting October 31; FDRG being convened in person this month to review vetting and consider finalization.

Nursing – convened at the end of November to consider a possible Model Curriculum

Philosophy – 1 draft descriptor posted for vetting; FDRG is reviewing vetting comments at this time; final TMC to post soon

Radio/TV/Film – TMC and draft descriptors to be posted this month for vetting

Spanish – watch for posting of final TMC and 2 descriptors soon
