## Update on Approved Courses and TMCs

Presently, **88 CCCs** have courses that have been granted C-ID numbers; range of courses approved is **1-80**

**1543 (+188 from June)** courses have been granted C-ID numbers in **17 disciplines**

**330 (140 AG) (+10 from June)** C-ID descriptors have been approved – in **28 disciplines**

**20 TMCs**

**4 more TMCs** will be considered for final approval in July (or early Fall):

**420 (+35 from June)** AA-T and AS-T aligned degrees approved in the Chancellor's Office (as of 6/29/12)

## Draft Discipline Status Report

**Accounting** - 2 descriptors finalized and to be posted soon

## Nursing and Engineering FDRG Update

**Nursing** FDRG met in June to begin their efforts to develop draft descriptors needed for their lower division nursing curriculum and a possible TMC or model curriculum. **Engineering** FDRG members met and will be working this summer and are meeting in early Sept. to work on developing draft descriptors and draft TMC(s) or model curriculum to be posted in Fall 2012.

## New AO Features

**Updating textbooks - Conditional Approvals** can be done easily with an added “comment box” in the re-submission area to provide updated texts, authors and dates. The AO has the option to update the COR but if they choose not to – the previous COR remains in place. This process applies to CORs whose conditional status required textbook updates only.

**Course submission list - Excel document now available for AOs** As was discussed at the C-ID breakout at the CIAC annual meeting, AOs can now download from the C-ID website an Excel document with all of your submitted courses. Log-in and go to your “View Submitted Courses” page and you will see a link to the Excel version of this list.

## **NEW**

An effective date field is now available when submitting or editing CORs. You may indicate a date up to one year in advance. If you indicate a future effective date, your approved course will not appear on the C-ID website until the effective date indicated.
