## Update on Approved Courses and TMCs

Presently, **88 CCCs** have courses that have been granted C-ID numbers; range of courses approved is **1-89**

**1793 (+250 from July)** courses have been granted C-ID numbers

**342 (140 AG) (+12 from June)** C-ID descriptors have been approved – in **30** disciplines

**20** TMCs

**4** more **TMCs** are currently being considered for final approval:

## Draft Discipline Status Report

**Anthropology** – 1 descriptor Intro to Language and Culture) re-posted for vetting until October 15

**Communication** – 1 draft descriptor (Persuasion) posted for vetting until October 15

**Economics** – 2 descriptors being finalized by FDRG and to be posted soon

**Kinesiology** – Kinesiology has recently drafted 5 descriptors for their activity courses and grouped them according to the activity areas (e.g. "aquatics"). They will be posted until October 15.

**Mathematics** – 8 draft descriptors to be re-posted for vetting in fall

## New Website Features (coming soon)

CSU AOs will soon be able to submit their C-ID identified comparable courses directly into the C-ID website – watch for details soon

Also, available soon will be website viewing of the identified courses by CSU campuses as comparable to C-ID descriptors.

## TCSU Approved Courses Expiring

TCSU courses already in the system with a date up to and including 2007 will be expiring on February 28, 2013. TCSU courses from 2008 will be expiring on September 30, 2013.

TCSU courses from 2009 will expire on September 30, 2014.

Courses that were granted TCSU numbers prior to 2008 will not automatically be granted a C-ID designation.

All other courses will come up for review five years from the date on the Course Outline of Record as entered upon submission of the course to C-ID.

## Effective Date Field

An effective date field is now available when submitting or editing CORs. You may indicate a date up to one year in advance. If you indicate a future effective date, your approved course will not appear on the C-ID website until the effective date indicated.
