## Update on Approved Courses and TMCs

Presently, 78 CCCs have courses that have been granted C-ID numbers.

**1057 (+31 from December)** courses have been granted C-ID numbers for **12 disciplines**

**252 (140 AG) 112 (w/out AG)** C-ID descriptors have been approved

**84** draft descriptors are presently being reviewed or finalized in a multitude of disciplines –**16** final TMCs; **2** TMCs currently being considered by the TMC Work Group - **280** degrees approved in the Chancellor's Office

## AO Alerts: TCSU courses & technical changes

- You can help the C-ID office by checking the **accuracy** of your courses that have been automatically granted a C-ID number due to the “grandfathering” of the TCSU approvals; we have found cases where these course numbers have been revised in the past few years since the TCSU number was initially granted.
- Please **check** all of your approved courses listed on the C-ID website for accuracy and e-mail Pam at [pam@c-id.net](mailto:pam@c-id.net) if you find courses that need to be updated/corrected.
- Any TCSU granted courses that are more than 5 years old at the time they are submitted to C-ID for review **WILL NOT** receive automatic approval and must be submitted via the regular C-ID review process.
- To submit a more recent CoR for a TCSU approved course: **AOs must choose the re-submit option – you will then be alerted that you have already used that descriptor and are requested to offer a reason for creating a “new” articulation for this descriptor**
- You may choose to leave the TCSU articulation in place until your course is approved via the course review process
- After course approval, you will need to delete your old TCSU based articulation
- For technical changes to your curriculum – prefix, number, increase in units choose the EDIT option on your submission page
