DESCRIPTOR BASED 4 – YEAR COLLEGE AND UNIVERSITY ARTICULATION IS GROWING ALL THE TIME!

- The 4-year descriptor-based articulation is available via a link on the **front page** of the C-ID website as well as under the Articulation Officer tab
- This matrix continues to be updated at least twice a month

CoR REVIEW PROCESS – bringing more CCC and CSU faculty on board

- Faculty Review Discipline Groups (FDRGs) and newly appointed CoR Evaluators (COREs) will be trained this summer for the course outline review process. Group and/or individual training is available.
- **Additional CCC and CSU faculty are currently being recruited to serve as CoR Evaluators. Increasing the number of faculty for course outline reviews will result in a more timely CoR submission and response process.**
- **If you know of faculty interested in participating as a CORE, please ask them to e-mail info@c-id.net**

SOME REMINDERS for the CoR submission process:

- Upload the CoR directly or link to the most up to date CoR
- **If you use OSCAR outlines, a new feature will remind you that the CoR must not be older than 5 years.**
- **PDF versions of your CoRs prove more reliable than WORD documents.**
- If necessary, your entries in C-ID can be updated/edited or deleted at any time **before** the review process begins

TCSU Automatic approval update

- When an FDRG is ready to post finalized C-ID descriptors, they determine if a descriptor is comparable to a TCSU descriptor/designation (if available) for that course.
- The Math and History FDRGs determined that some of their descriptors were significantly different from TCSU descriptors, thereby requiring those courses to be submitted for CoR review.

DESCRIPTOR DISCIPLINE UPDATE – next review period ends October 16

- Due to the need for more faculty review of descriptors, some disciplines have been re-posted descriptors for faculty vetting to the C-ID website. **IT IS CRITICAL** that the disciplines get more faculty reviews – notices of the re-postings and new draft postings for vetting are sent via the discipline list-serves. Visit <http://www.c-id.net/listserv.html> and sign up your faculty for their discipline list-serves to ensure they receive information to participate in the development and vetting of degrees in their field
- AOs are also welcome to sign up for any discipline list serve so they receive notification of descriptor postings and finalizations
