SUBJECT: CSU, FULLERTON 2012-13 LOWER DIVISION CURRICULAR CHANGES

ARTICULATION BY MAJOR:

BA – BUSINESS ADMIN – Management Science concentration has a name change.
New name: Decision Sciences.

BA – COMMUNICATIONS – Entertainment Studies concentration has a name change.
New name: Entertainment and Tourism Communications.

BA – ETHNIC STUDIES – AFRO-ETHNIC STUDIES has a name change.
New name: BA- Ethnic Studies – African American Studies.

BA – LIBERAL STUDIES – Elementary Education Plan Core Courses (30 units, upper division only). Elementary Education Plan – Pre-Professional Courses (21 units). MATH 303A removed as a required course; major department will still accept course as an elective for the major. MATH 303B is the new required course.

BS – MECHANICAL ENGINEERING – minimum units for degree is 137 (previously listed as 134 on ASSIST).

BS – NURSING – RN-BSN Degree – minimum units required for degree is 120 (was 123). Prerequisite courses have been revised for Fall2012. New prerequisites: Oral Communication, Written Communication, Critical Thinking, **Statistics**, Anatomy and Physiology with lab, Microbiology with lab, and Chemistry.
