Effective Fall 2015: Bachelor of Science in Environmental Science (Department of Geography and Environment)

The Bachelor of Science in Environmental Science is designed for students intending to prepare for graduate school or for direct entry into a career as an environmental scientist or environmental manager in industry or government. The curriculum comprises a core providing a foundation of science and methods courses -- introductory earth systems and environmental science, biology, chemistry, physics and mathematics – as well as distributed electives in environmental science, environmental management and analytical methods, and a capstone proseminar. Students can tailor their program in a variety of ways, to focus on water, soils and agriculture, biotic systems, restoration science, coastal systems, bioclimatology, pollution management, protected land management, water resources management, or others.
