ELIGIBILITY FOR GRADUATION:

- 1. Complete a minimum of 60 Associate Degree applicable units.
- 2. Complete all units required for the major (a minimum of 18 semester units of course work are required; however, many majors require more than 18 units consult the <u>catalog</u> for specific major course requirements and any recency limitations).
- 3. Complete a minimum of 12 units in residence as an officially enrolled student at the college granting the degree (a minimum of 6 units from the major must be completed at City, Mesa, or Miramar College).
- 4. Complete a minimum of 18 units of General Education courses, with a minimum of one course in each sub-area.
- 5. Complete/satisfy District Requirements courses.
- 6. Achieve a cumulative grade point average of at least 2.0 ("C" average) in the curriculum upon which the degree is based. A grade of "C" or better must be earned in courses required for the major; up to 12 units of "P" (pass) grades count for degree Note: Students who are following a different catalog year should refer to previous <u>catalogs</u> for other approved courses.
