2023–2024 High School Graduation Verification for ATB mismatch

- A. High School Completion Status
- B. Provide one of the following documents to the San Diego Mesa College Financial Aid Office that indicates your high school completion status when you will begin college in 2022–2023:
- High school diploma.
 - General Educational Development (GED) certificate or GED transcript.
 - If your State of residency law requires a homeschooled student to obtain a secondary school completion credential for homeschool (other than a high school diploma or its recognized equivalent), a copy of that credential.
 - If your State of residency law does not require a homeschooled student to obtain a secondary high school completion credential for homeschool (other than a high school diploma or its recognized equivalent), a transcript or the equivalent, signed by your parent, guardian, or registrar from the homeschool that lists the secondary school courses you completed and documents the successful completion of a secondary school education in a homeschool setting.
 - If you were homeschooled and completed the California Dream Application, you must provide a copy of your parent’s teaching certification issued by the State of California.
 - Academic transcript of a student who has successfully completed at least a two-year program that is acceptable for full credit toward a bachelor's degree.
- C. Early Graduates. For students who complete High School graduation requirements and graduate mid-year [between the Fall and Spring semesters] please provide your *Letter or Early Graduation* to the Financial Aid Office.
