



2024-2025 Verification Worksheet for Independent Student (LVRWSI-#12)

Your 2024-2025 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) was selected for review in a process called verification. The federal government requires that prior to awarding Federal Student Aid, the school may ask you to confirm the information you reported on your FAFSA. To verify that you provided correct information, San Diego Mesa College will compare your FAFSA with the information on this worksheet and with any other required documents. Based on the information provided, your FAFSA information may need to be corrected.

The provided criteria for "dependent children" or "other persons" align with the requirement that family size align with whom the student could claim as a dependent on a U.S. tax return if the student were to file a U.S tax return at the time of completing the 2024-2025 FAFSA. As a result, the student should not include any unborn children in the family size.
